6. "So he went to his father and said, 'My father'; and he said, 'Here I am. Who are you, my son?' And Jacob said to his father, 'I am Esau your firstborn; I have done just as you told me; please arise, sit and eat of my game, that your soul may (**BLESS**, **CURSE**) me.'" **GENESIS 27:18-19**
7. "Esau said, 'Is he not rightly named Jacob? For he has (**SUPPLANTED**, **PLANTED**) me these two times. He took away my birthright, and now look, he has taken away my blessing!' " **GENESIS 27:36**
8. "So Esau (**LOVED**, **HATED**) Jacob because of the blessing with which his father blessed him, and Esau said in his heart, 'The days of mourning for my father are at hand; then I will kill my brother Jacob.'" **GENESIS 27:41**
9. After Isaac blessed Jacob, he "sent Jacob away, and he went to Padan Aram, to (**LABAN**, **ABRAM**) the son of Bethuel the Syrian, the brother of Rebekah, the mother of Jacob and Esau." **GENESIS 28:5**
10. Jacob feared his brother, but when he returned to the land of Canaan, "Esau (**WALKED**, **RAN**) to meet him, and embraced him, and fell on his neck and kissed him, and they wept." **GENESIS 33:4**
11. Jacob said to Esau, 'Please, take my blessing that is brought to you, because (**GOD**, **LABAN**) has dealt graciously with me, and because I have enough.' And he urged him, and he took it." **GENESIS. 33:11**

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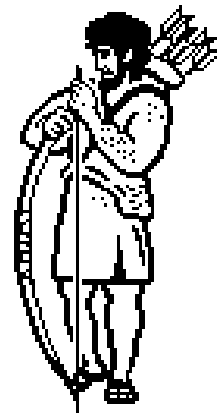

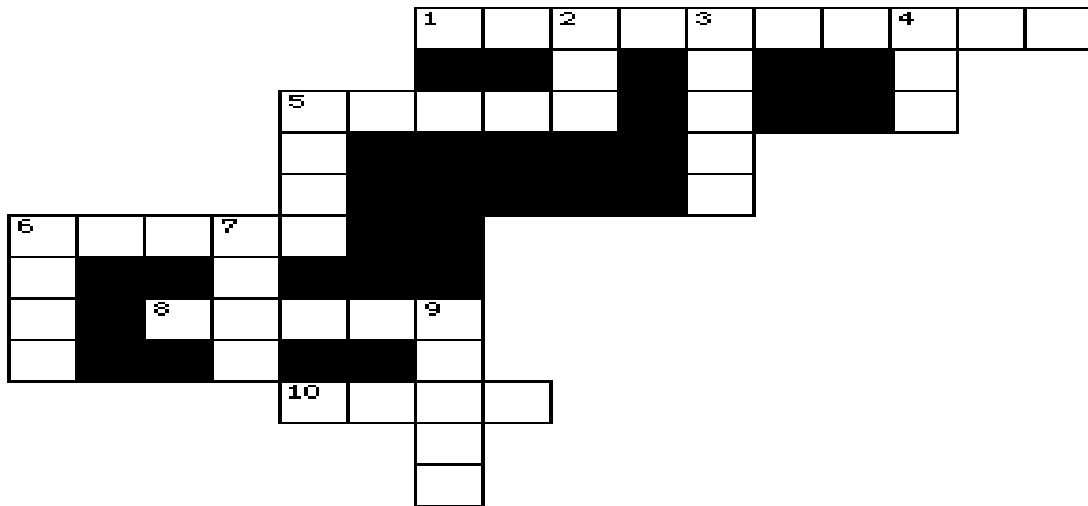
