

Sunday School Lesson Activity

Jesus offers living water to a Samaritan woman at Jacob's well (John 4)

1. Cut out the well on this page. Leave the circle attached to the edge of the wall.
2. Roll the wall into a cylinder shape and fasten with tape. Overlap some of the stone pattern about one inch to match the circumference of the circle.
3. Cut out the water puddles and water drop.
4. Place the water puddles around the well as you talk about each one.



Each of the puddles represent items that do not offer permanent satisfaction. They are like spilled water. Each of them may make you happy for a short time, but only eternal life can offer the guarantee that you will "never thirst again" (John 4:13-14)

5. Ask the students to write some of their own ideas on the water puddles. What do they like that only satisfies for a short time?
6. Put the water drop inside the well. It is printed upside down to represent "a well of water springing up into everlasting life" (John 4:14).
