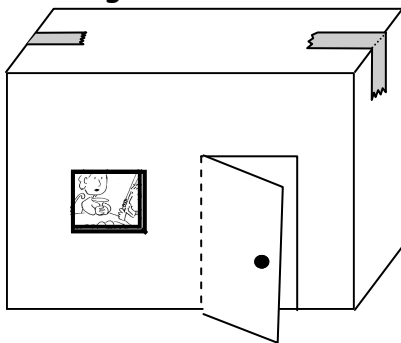


The Passover Plague

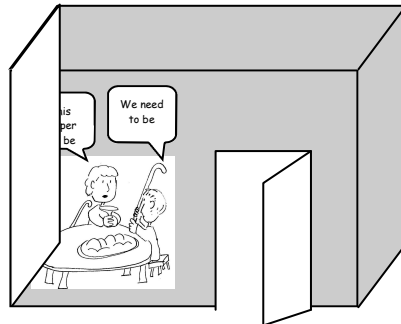
This is a printable project to re-create the scene of the night of the Passover in Egypt. With scissors and tape, you can create a small object lesson to use in a Bible class.

Directions

1. Read the Bible story of the Passover in Exodus 11 to 12.
2. Print this document. To save some ink on your printer, you may print page 4 and 5 (line art) in stead of 2 and 3 (colored bricks).
3. Cut, fold and tape the houses as shown in the diagram below.

4. Tape the pictures of the two families inside the house as shown on the right.

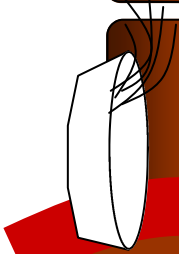

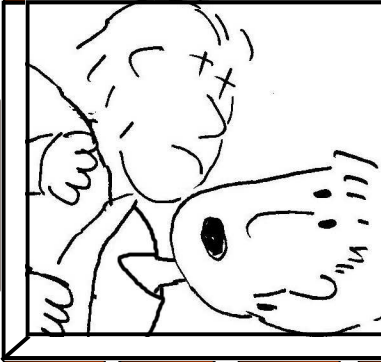
